Rebecca Gates is a U.S. based musician, artist, activist and soundworker whose practice spans performance, installation, design, and curation. She has released five albums, including three as leader of the critically acclaimed group The Spinanes (Sub Pop), toured globally, and appeared as a vocalist on numerous records by artists such as Elliott Smith, The Decemberists and Willie Nelson. Gates produces programs and symposiums and co-curated The Marfa Sessions, an exhibition of sonic land art installations at Ballroom Marfa, Texas. She is affiliate faculty at Virginia Commonwealth University School of the Arts in Richmond, VA, teaching sound art, site-specific sound studies and sonic commons.
